Dear Bargaining Unit Member,

Please find attached a summary of the St. Lucie Classroom Teachers' Association/Classified Unit's (CTA/CU) signed agreements with the St. Lucie County School Board for compensation and benefits for 2018-2019 and additional language signed since the last ratification in August 2017.

The ratification vote will take place on Wednesday, December 5, 2018 at the CTA/CU office at 371 East Midway Road in Ft. Pierce. The Letters of Understanding (LOU's) and full text of the contract language is attached, is available on our website at www.stluciateachers.com, at our office, or on our Facebook page.

Voting will take place **ONLY** on December 5, 2018. All eligible bargaining unit members may vote between 7:00 a.m. – 7:00 p.m. and you **must bring picture ID**. The polls will close at 7:00 p.m. and no one will be allowed to join the voting lines after that time. Anyone in line at 7:00 p.m. will be allowed to vote. Bargaining unit members wishing to vote an absentee ballot may do so by coming to the CTA/CU office during the office hours of 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. on Monday and Tuesday, December 3rd and 4th to cast a ballot if not able to do so on the date of the ratification election. **Ballots cannot be sent to you by mail or interoffice mail.**

To be eligible to vote, you must be a member of the CTA/CU bargaining unit which means you are either a teacher or other instructional staff or you are a member of the non-instructional staff including clerical, paraprofessionals, aides, etc. You do not have to be a member of the union to vote but you must be represented by the bargaining unit. **You may not vote if you are a school secretary, custodial staff, cafeteria staff, full/part-time subs, and those employees who are not part of the defined bargaining unit.**
